Arjan te Pas works as a **Consultant Neonatologist** in a tertiary neonatal intensive care unit (650 admissions per year) in Leiden University Medical Center with a full time clinical position since 2003. He earned his PhD for his work related to spontaneous breathing and respiratory support of preterm infants at birth. During his PhD he worked as a research fellow in the Royal Women's Hospital (2007-2008). In LUMC he has set up a new research program "perinatal transition and neonatal resuscitation".

Arjan te Pas is an adjunct research fellow of the Ritchie Centre, Monash University and closely collaborate with Prof Stuart Hooper (fetal/neonatal physiologist), who leads the physiological research team at the Ritchie Centre. This collaboration is a truly bi-directional (clinic-to-laboratory-to-clinic) research program.
